

**CENTENNIAL CROSSING METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NOS. 1, 2, 3, AND 8  
AMENDED CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL REPORT  
TO  
THE TOWN OF MILLIKEN  
FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022**

Pursuant to the Article VII of the Consolidated Service Plan for the Centennial Crossing Metropolitan District Nos. 1-8, the Districts are required to submit an annual report to the Town Administrator's Office for the Town of Milliken no later than August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year following the year in which the Order and Decree creating the Districts has been issued.

For the year ending December 31, 2022, the District makes the following report:

District No. 1 has received a certification of valuation from the Weld County Assessor that reports a taxable assessed valuation for the District for 2022 of \$10,770, for collection in 2023. The District certified a mill levy of 45.000 mills to be assessed against the properties within the District.

District No. 2 has received a certification of valuation from the Weld County Assessor that reports a taxable assessed valuation for the District for 2022 of \$14,140,500, for collection in 2023. The District certified a mill levy of 45.000 mills to be assessed against the properties within the District.

District No. 3 has received a certification of valuation from the Weld County Assessor that reports a taxable assessed valuation for the District for 2022 of \$7,133,560, for collection in 2023. The District certified a mill levy of 45.000 mills to be assessed against the properties within the District.

District No. 8 has received a certification of valuation from the Weld County Assessor that reports a taxable assessed valuation for the District for 2022 of \$6,052,430, for collection in 2023 The District certified a mill levy of 45.000 mills to be assessed against the properties within the District.
